VILLAGE OF BLANCHESTER, ORDINANCE NO. 2024.012

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE H2OHIO RIVERS CHLORIDE REDUCTION STATE GRANT AWARD AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE VILLAGE OF BLANCHESTER

WHEREAS, on August 1, 2024, the Village of Blanchester ("Village") was notified it was selected to receive the H2Ohio River Chloride Reduction Grant;

WHEREAS, the Ohio EPA granted \$50,000 to the Village to renovate the salt storage bin maintained by the Village's Street Department.

WHEREAS, the renovated salt storage bin will reduce the potential for contamination in surrounding waterways and prevent the salt bin from collapsing.

WHEREAS, the Village finds it to be in the best interests of the health, safety, and welfare of the Village of Blanchester to receive the Grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Blanchester, Clinton County, Ohio:

<u>Section 1</u>. The Mayor is authorized and directed to execute, on behalf of the Village of Blanchester, H2ohio Rivers Chloride Reduction State Grant Award Agreement.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of Council, and that all deliberations of the Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

<u>Section 3.</u> This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and it shall be effective upon its passage. The reason for the emergency is to receive the funding as expeditiously as possible.
