VILLAGE OF BLANCHESTER, ORDINANCE NO. <u>2024.015</u>

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING FUND LEVEL TRANSFERS

WHEREAS, the Village of Blanchester ("Village") paid \$29,497.20 for two (2) police vehicles from the Legacy Grant Fund (2901);

WHEREAS, the Byrne Discretionary Community Fund (2904) is a reimbursable grant for the purchase of emergency vehicles.

WHEREAS, the Village finds it to be in the best interests of the health, safety, and welfare of the Village of Blanchester to transfer \$29,497.20 from the Byrne Discretionary Fund (2904) to the Legacy Grant Fund (2901).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Blanchester, Clinton County, Ohio:

Section 1. The Council for the Village of Blanchester hereby authorizes the transfer of \$29,497.20 from the Byrne Discretionary Community Fund (2904) to the Legacy Grant Fund (2901).

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of Council, and that all deliberations of the Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and it shall be effective on the earliest date allowed by law. The reason for the emergency is to ensure timely compliance with financial deadlines.
